



EVENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

Thursday 4th & Friday 5th April 2024

Details of the 2024 Prologue Spring Classic Car Tour are described in these terms & conditions but the main points are:

- EVENT** It is a social event and does not have any competitive elements.
- ELIGIBLE CARS** All classic, historic and replica cars built before 31st December 1999, although examples of more modern classics will be accepted at the organisers' discretion.
- ENTRY** Entry Fee is £925 for a crew of two for those entries received and paid for in full before 31st January 2024.
- ROUTE** The event will start at a venue to be arranged, and will finish at the Avisford Park Hotel, Yapton Lane, Walberton, Arundel, West Sussex BN18 0LS. The route of approximately 100 miles each day will take participants through picturesque countryside & will visit places of interest.
- ROUTE BOOK** An easy to follow "Tulip" Route Book will be provided.
- HOTEL** The entry fee includes the cost of 2 nights accommodation with breakfast and 2 evening meals at the Avisford Park Hotel, Yapton Lane, Walberton, Arundel, West Sussex BN18 0LS. Your stay will be from Thursday the 4th and Friday 5th April 2024 and check out Saturday 6th April 2024. Details are in Appendix A to these T & C's.

1 - Definition of the Event

- 1.1 The Prologue Spring Classic Tour is a Touring Assembly for road cars. The event is not a competition.
- 1.2 The event will take place on Thursday 4th and Friday 5th April 2024.

2 - Organisation

- 2.1 The event is organised by Brit Assist Limited under these terms & conditions and any additional advice which may be issued. Any such additional instructions will be deemed to be an appendix to and have the same power as these terms & conditions.
- 2.2 All Participants undertake to comply with these terms & conditions by the fact of their entry.

3 - Route

- 3.1 The full route will cover approximately 200 miles in and around Sussex and the surrounding Counties. To be arranged and further details will follow.

4 - Entrants

- 4.1 All cars must meet the legal requirements to run on public roads and be in a roadworthy condition. It is the responsibility of each participant to ensure that the car is in a state of roadworthiness appropriate to the type of event. The use of trade plates is not permitted.
- 4.2 No advertising trade sign or promotional display may be carried on or distributed from any vehicle without the prior consent of the Organisers.
- 4.3 The maximum number of entries will be 35, plus 5 reserves. All entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis. The Organisers may increase or decrease the number of entries at their discretion.
- 4.4 Participants will be provided with a numbered rigid plate (approximately 12" x 6" – 30cm x 15cm) which must be clearly displayed in a forward facing position at the front of the car and removed once the event has finished. No other numbers may be displayed except vehicle registration plates.

5 - Eligible Participants and Drivers

- 5.1 Any person may enter the event but all drivers must hold a valid driving licence for the car being driven. A competition licence is not required.

6 - Entries

- 6.1 Entries open with the publication of these terms & conditions and close on 31st January 2024. The cost of an entry is £925. A reservation deposit of £150 secures a place and participants holding reserved entries must submit a completed entry form together with a payment for the balance of the entry fee £775 - by 31st January 2024. Failure to do so will result in the deposit

being forfeited and the entry offered to a reserve.

- 6.2 For completed entries received and paid in full by 31st January 2024, the entry fee is £925 per car (crew of two - driver and passenger). Includes:
- 2 nights Bed & breakfast for two people in an en-suite twin or double room at the Avisford Park Hotel, Yapton Road, Walberton, Arundel, West Sussex BN18 0LS.
 - Evening dinner on both the Thursday and Friday Evenings
 - Morning coffee and/or lunches – To be arranged
 - Entrance fee to places of interest
 - Easy to follow Tulip Route Book
 - A rigid identification plate for the vehicle
 - The vehicle breakdown and recovery services of Brit Assist's team of experienced mechanics.

Additional passengers will be charged appropriately please ask.

- 6.3 There is an option of participating on a one-day tour which excludes Hotel accommodation and evening meals. Please ask for further details.
- 6.4 Any extra costs incurred at the overnight hotel or at places of interest must be settled direct with the venue before departure.
- 6.5 Entries will be accepted in order of receipt and will be acknowledged by email. The selection of entries is at the absolute discretion of the Organisers and will be final. The Organisers may refuse an entry without giving any reason.
- 6.6 Any change of vehicle must be notified in writing to the Organisers.
- 6.7 Participants withdrawing their entries may have all or part of their entry fee at the organiser's discretion, (dependant on deposits paid to venues), returned as follows:
- a) Entry withdrawn before the closing date for entries (31st January 2024) - refund of entry fee less £50 administration charge.
 - b) Entry withdrawn after the final closing date for entries will be at the organiser's discretion and dependant on how much has already been paid out in deposits for the venues.

Any withdrawal of entry must be submitted to the Organisers in writing, by post or e-mail.

- 6.8 A list of accepted Participants will be published a week before the event.

7 - Documentation & Eligibility Checking

- 7.1 All Participants will be required to sign a declaration on the documentation card that they have valid insurance in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act and the relevant national laws applicable to the route.

- 7.2 At the start, Participants will be given their Route Book showing the suggested route to be followed and the location of any venues.

8 - Outside Assistance & Tender Vehicles

- 8.1 Cars and drivers are permitted to receive outside assistance but tender vehicles will not be permitted. Breakdown services will be available to all Participants during the event courtesy of Brit Assist Ltd.

9 - Start & Re-start

- 9.1 Cars will start the event at 1 minute intervals. Cars will be numbered according to the date of their entry and the organisers may allow slower cars to start earlier if they wish and friends wanting to travel together.

- 9.2 Start times are as follows:
Thursday 4th April 2024 Car 1: TBC – Depending on Location
Friday 5th April 2024 Car 1: 09:30 (approximately)

10 - Venues

- 10.1 The route will include venues which will be shown in the Route Book, and approximate times of arrival and departure will be shown.

11 - Postponement or Cancellation

- 11.1 The Organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event or any part thereof should circumstances arise which make such action desirable or necessary. In such conditions the return of entry fees in whole or part will be at the discretion of the Organisers.

12 - Jurisdiction

- 12.1 The Organisers have absolute discretion in the application and amendment of a penalty for any breach of the terms & conditions and may implement decisions on any matter not provided for by these terms & conditions.

Appendix A – Hotel

For those participating on the 2-day Prologue Spring Classic Tour, the entry fee includes Bed and breakfast at the Avisford Park Hotel or if circumstances dictate at alternative hotels of a comparable standard.
